



Sturminster Marshall Platinum Jubilee Trail



Sturminster Marshall Platinum Jubilee Trail has been created to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee and recognise her 70 years of service to our country. It will be opened by the Wimborne Town Crier and other local dignitaries in a ceremony on the village green on Sunday 5th June at 11 am and will be followed by a prize-winning treasure hunt round the trail for families and children.

The trail features a variety of old buildings and sites of historical interest which have been identified through the village and are marked by unique Jubilee Trail markers. The trail starts at St Mary's Church and passes in a circular route through the village to include:

Trafalgar Green, Walnut Tree Field, Timber Green (Stocks Green), Charborough Green, Churchill Green (Village green) and Maypole Green (Market Place).
